

Image Delivery Specs

Hello!

We are really looking forward to seeing your stills for this production. Please deliver your images in RAW as well as High Res JPG format as per the instructions below:

RAW files:

Please deliver your RAW files either as TIFF or DNG files.

JPG files:

Please deliver JPG files at their maximum resolution and quality.

*****Double-check you have the same number of JPG to RAW files to ensure nothing is missing or duplicated*****

File naming:

Please ensure your file naming follows this protocol:

PRODUCTION-NAME_ShootDay_PhottographersInitials_4DigitSequenceNumber

1. Start each day's image count at 1.
2. Your RAW and JPG files that correspond to one another must have EXACTLY the same file name.
3. **Do not include periods (.) in any part of your filename other than the format extension eg .JPG .DNG etc. Doing so risks corrupting your images.**

For example, the first image taken by Aimee Spinks on shoot day 6 of the show "Outlander" would have the following file name:

Outlander_Day006_AS_0001.JPG
Outlander_Day006_AS_0001.DNG

Folder Structure:

Please ensure your folder structure is one level deep. For example:

Day 001 – 1st Jan – RAW
Day 001 – 1st Jan – JPG
Day 003 – 3rd Jan – RAW
Day 003 – 3rd Jan - JPG
